- Return all library materials on time or pay all fines before borrowing other materials
- Report the loss of library card; patron is responsible for the use of the card until it has been reported lost

Community Borrower cards are \$50.00 with a yearly renewal rate of \$25.00.

To apply, bring the following to the Library's Information Desk:

- Your Texas Driver's License or picture ID
- Proof of local address that contains your name and residential address
- Payment in cash or check



Borrowing From the Library

All guests are welcome to browse and use materials while in the Library.

Community Borrower card holders may borrow materials for the following loan periods:

Bestsellers - 1st floor

4 weeks

Limit two at a time.

Audiovisual Media - 1st floor

Circulation Desk

DVD/VHS: 1 week

Limit two at a time.

Circulating books - 3rd floor

4 weeks

Using Library Computers

Community Borrower card holders receive unlimited use of library computers including:

- Use of Library subscription databases and resources
- Microsoft Office Suite software
- Free printing (donations accepted)

Log in to Library computers by entering your 9-digit Community Borrower number as both the login and password (include the "CB" with no spaces). To insure the security of your account, log off of the computer when you are finished. Do not give your borrower's number to others.

Online Library Account

Community Borrower card holders can renew borrowed materials, place holds, and manage their Library accounts online:

- Visit library.sulross.edu
- Click on "Review My Account" or "Renew My Materials"
- Enter your Community Borrower number and your PIN number.
- Call the library if you have issues.
