February 24, 2000 The Texas Cowboy Poetry Gathering celebrated their 14th year in Alpine. Founded in 1986 by Dr. Barney Nelson, Cowboy Poetry is the second oldest poetry gathering in the U.S. The 14th annual meeting boasted 50 artists, almost 90 performances, and, of course, the now infamous fresh-baked biscuits at the chuck wagon dinner. Today, the event has taken a new name as the Lone Star Cowboy Poetry Gathering.
